Natalia Cole will be accepting art students for after-school lessons. For price and times, please call Natalia at 244-7461.

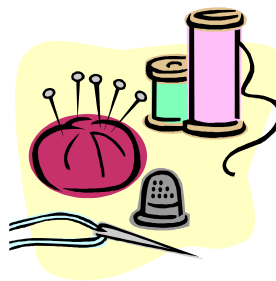
### **Donice is in the house!**
